



SUN TERRACE

The sun terrace design links the garden areas around the ponds, lawns and the conservatory. The terrace uses reclaimed Yorkstone paving to match with existing paving and provides a large seating area to enjoy the last of the days sun and uninterrupted views of the South Cambridgeshire countryside. The construction of the large oak pergola accentuates the link between the garden, terrace, conservatory and herb garden and provides support for *Wisteria* and *Vitis coignetiae* helping to create a more shaded area underneath.

Large planting beds break up the terrace and provide a sense of direction and flow. The planting of *Lavandula 'Richard Grey'* around the terrace carries on a theme used in other parts of the garden and also gives a lovely scent. The blue flowers contrast well on the bright silvery grey foliage that stands very well in the winter. The dimensions of the circular planting beds are carried through into the herb and vegetable gardens where they exist as gravel pathways.
