Across the estate visitors can see an array of interesting and beautiful livestock many of which provide produce for the house and kitchen. White peacocks rub shoulders with free range pigs, Chinese geese, Angora goats, runner ducks and black rock chickens.

2010 also saw the introduction of bees and the production of the first pots of South Farm honey. The free range black rock chickens have two houses in the shady coppice and roam into the extensive grazing paddock beyond. Consequently the chickens and bantams produce fantastically rich and tasty eggs for the kitchen. The grazing paddocks are not only home to the pigs and chickens but are also part of the newly planted arboretum.
